

Later, EMF turned to Europe as Uberti and other companies began the replica firearms industry there. During the past 50 Years, EMF has traveled the world to bring “The Best in Cowboy Guns” to America, importing from Italy, Germany, Spain, Turkey and Brazil. Recently, EMF has come full circle with the introduction of the Great Western II, an all-new, thoroughly authentic copy of the original 1873 Colt.






CAVALRY




