### How To Select A Riflelescope

Purchasing the right riflelescope for your personal needs can make all the difference to your success in the field.

Simply put, every scope can make targets easier to see and hit. They make targets appear closer and help with the precise, fast placement of each shot. Plus they can improve visibility in low-light conditions, such as dawn and dusk.

But the science of optics is a series of trade-offs. Field of view (the width in area you can see through a scope), eye relief (the distance your eye can be from the scope and still see the full field of view), and magnification are all related. If you want more of one, you will have to sacrifice something somewhere else.

As a result, the following options generally apply:

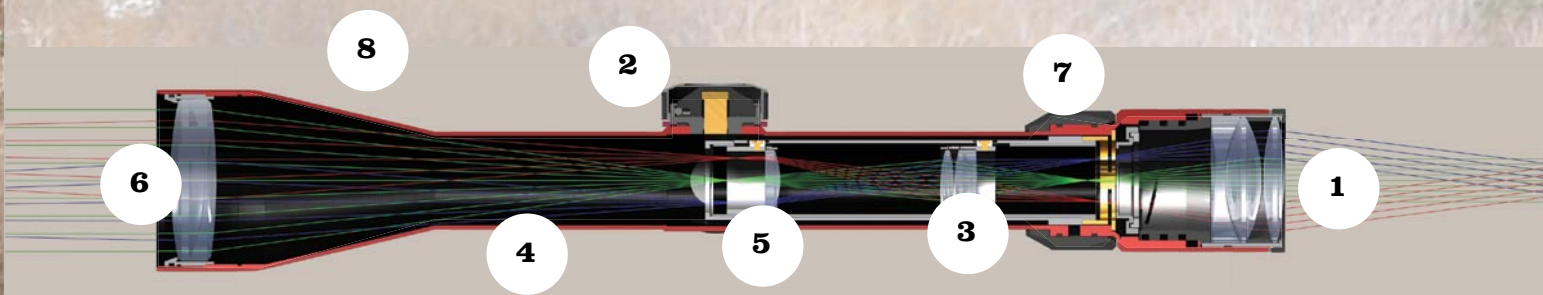
For all-around, general purpose – such as hunting whitetail deer – a mid-range 3-9 power scope that provides a good balance of magnification and field of view is usually a good choice.

For close-in, faster targets – a scope with less magnification and a wider field of view is advised. A 1.5-5 power scope or a Red Dot could be perfect for your turkey gun, slug gun or early-season muzzleloader.

For small, distant targets – such as varmints or small X rings – where it's possible to get a good rest, a more powerful 4–14 or 6–24 scope would be a good choice.

For low-light conditions – a larger objective (front) lens will gather more light and produce a brighter image.

Regardless of your choice, you can be assured there's a high-quality Simmons scope available for your specific needs.

Today's heavier loads and great recoil demand longer eye relief (the distance between the shooter's eye and the scope's eyepiece). The QTA eyepiece overcomes this challenge by providing a constant eye relief of 3.5 or more inches throughout the entire power range – rather than shrinking it as the power goes up, as most scopes do.



Available on all Master Series scopes, the QTA eyepiece gives shooters a larger eyebox – the optical sweet spot with clear, in-focus viewing. With QTA, you get more vertical, horizontal, forward and backward movement behind the scope, so you can shoot faster and more accurately when shooting uphill or from a prone or awkward position. Simmons' easy-to-grip Fast Focus eyepiece makes setting the scope to your eye quick and easy, even when wearing thick gloves.

## 2. Steel-On-Steel TrueZero™ Windage And Elevation Adjustments For Accurate, Reliable Clicks

TrueZero uses a ball-bearing and spring system that applies direct steel-on-steel pressure to maintain adjustments and hold zero year after year.

Impervious to wear, the system is completely sealed and waterproof – even with the caps off – unlike all but the most expensive scopes.

## 3. TrueZero™ Adjustment System – Holds Zero With 300% More Force

Simmons' patented TrueZero windage and elevation adjustment system takes the internal erector tube (which holds the lenses) and attaches it to the scope tube – instead of using only one screw and one leaf spring to hold a loose erector in place, as most riflescopes do.

Featured on all Master Series scopes, TrueZero spreads the recoil across the entire base of the lens housing, instead of focusing recoil on just one screw. This dramatically reduces recoil impact to the lenses and erector, while providing 300% more holding force – so zero and parallax are locked in, even after 1,000 rounds from a .375 H&H magnum rifle or 12-gauge slug gun firing a 3.5" shell.

Once zero is adjusted, it's locked in for years, so you'll never again have to tap on the turret to be sure adjustments are set. And because TrueZero eliminates the tube space needed by traditional leaf spring adjustment systems, you get 17% more windage and elevation travel.

## 4. A One-Piece Main Tube For Solid Durability And Light Weight

Crafted as a single unit from aircraft-quality aluminum, all Master Series scopes integrate the objective and eyepiece into the scope tube, instead of attaching them as added components.
