

Later, EMF turned to Europe as Uberti and other companies began the replica firearms industry there. During the past 50 Years, EMF has traveled the world to bring "The Best in Cowboy Guns" to America, importing from Italy, Germany, Spain, Turkey and Brazil. Recently, EMF has come full circle with the introduction of the Great Western II, an all-new, thoroughly authentic copy of the original 1873 Colt.





Spencer, known as a prominent figure in the machine industry, improved upon the original design of his earlier model carbine and manufactured one of the most reliable, accurate and sought after carbines of the era. ### 1860 Henry Rifles

Approximately 14,000 rifles bearing the name of the inventor, B. Tyler Henry, were produced, mostly during the Civil War. Commonly referred to as ".....that damn Yankee gun that is loaded on Sunday and shoots all week...." by the Confederate soldiers on the other end of its muzzle. The Henry was the first repeating rifle of its kind.



The 1848 Dragoon revolver featured several improvements over its predecessor, the Walker, including an improved loading lever, lighter weight and shorter cylinder. The Dragoon pistol was the first Colt revolver to be purchased by the U.S. military. EMF's reproduction of this famous revolver is made by A. Uberti.

### 1851 NAVY AND SHERIFF

Available in either steel frame or brass frame, this revolver received its name from the depiction on the cylinder of the Texas Navy's victory over the Mexican fleet in 1843. EMF's reproduction is available in either 36 or 44 caliber and 5 1/2" or 7 1/2" barrel length.

### 1860 ARMY AND SHERIFF

The 1860 Army saw extensive use during the Civil War and was a favored sidearm of Union troops. Built on the same frame as the 1851 Navy, it featured a streamlined barrel, improved loading lever and a belted cylinder for added strength.
