^{1.} Veterans may refinance via Interest Rate Reduction Refinance Loan, to convert a fixed- rate loan to an ARM loan. The interest rate on the new loan must be less than the interest rate on the existing loan. The principal and interest payment of the IRRRL must be less than the principal and interest payment of the current loan unless, either: the term of the IRRRL is less than the current loan; an adjustable rate mortgage is being refinanced to a fixed rate mortgage; or the increase of the monthly principal and interest payment is attributed to the inclusion of Energy Efficient Improvements.
